What is Scale Remover?



Scale Remover™ - is a powerful scale remover using Nano-Natural Technology, designed to remove body oil, soap film and hard water deposits from a variety of surfaces. Scale Remover™ is non-corrosive, non-fuming, and non-toxic and dissolves more scale than competitive products which contain hazardous acids. Nano-Natural Technology involves small molecular structures which dissolve and remove soil from any surface without using chemicals. Scale Remover™ breaks down body oil, soap film and mineral deposits into microscopic particles that disperse in water and repel one another. The particles are then easy to remove and less likely to re-adhere to the cleaned surfaces. The molecular structure of these particles are so small they can forcefully penetrate molecules of daunting deposits for quick and easy removal.



How to Apply?

Showers:

Apply solution to walls using a wall mop or sponge. Start at the bottom and work up. Allow product to remain on the walls for a few minutes. Agitate and rinse the walls and fixtures with clean water. Follow the same procedure for cleaning shower floors.



Restrooms:

Apply by spraying onto surface. Agitate with a brush, sponge, or cloth. Rinse the surface with water and wipe clean with a cloth.

Toilets/Urinals:

Clean outside of toilet and the seat, top and bottom, including pipes, hinges and entire base of the bowl. Wash inside of toilet with bowl brush and flush to rinse.

Glass:

Apply by spraying onto glass surface, allow product to remain on the glass for a minute. Agitate surface with a brush or sponge. Rinse with water or wipe surface clean with a cloth.



Foodservice:

Spray on equipment, such as stainless steel tables, steam tables and food-preparation areas. Agitate with a brush or cloth and rinse or wipe dry.

Where to Use?

Sinks, showers, toilets, drinking fountains, fixtures, food-preparation areas and glass.
